Swan Hill District Health (SHDH) is a sub-regional referral hospital servicing a large, but sparsely populated area of Northern Victoria and South Western New South Wales. The rural city of Swan Hill has a population of 10,000 people with the hospital servicing a catchment population estimated at 35,000. SHDH is one of four major hospitals in the Loddon Mallee region and provides a wide range of acute inpatient, community rehabilitation, aged residential, domiciliary and primary care, dental services and General Practice, including outreach programs to several small outlying communities.

As a leading sub-regional health service, SHDH has been responding to industry changes, while also implementing improvements to the delivery of patient care. Most recently this includes: the introduction of telehealth services GeriConnect, tele-fracture and tele-oncology clinics and Endocrinology telehealth; completion of the University School of Rural Health Swan Hill building and expansion of the fourth year medical student intake in 2018/2019; completion of a new Counselling facility and construction of a purpose-built Headspace facility; and expansion of the Dental Clinic.

The Chief Executive Officer at SHDH is responsible, directly to the Board, for the total operational and financial performance of the Health Service and for compliance with its legal and statutory obligations. The Board is seeking a senior and experienced executive to provide leadership to the executive staff of the organisation and to develop and implement services, facilities and resources which provide the highest possible standard of health care to the Swan Hill and District community. This is a unique opportunity for a high performing health executive to lead and develop this vital community organisation.
