About the Swan Hill Region

Swan Hill District Health offers a unique setting for a District Health Service. Sitting on the banks of the Murray River, we employ approximately 450 staff and service a community of around 30,000 people.

We are 2 hours from Bendigo, 3 hours from Mildura and 3.5 hours from Melbourne by car. We also have a convenient train service to Melbourne that runs twice a day. The challenge is to service our community with the highest quality health care, sometimes without "around the corner" back up.



History:

Founded by a group of concerned squatters of the district in the 1860's Swan Hill District Health has today become a symbol of the hopes and strivings, the courage and generosity of the community it has served for more than a century and a half. Beset with difficulties from the outset, the hospital has managed to overcome financial and staffing problems with the help of the surrounding community.

Our District:

Traditionally focused on primary production and supplying the needs of people and businesses in the area, Swan Hill has broadened its activities in commerce, manufacturing and tourism. The city today combines the relaxed lifestyle and community spirit of traditional rural life, with the facilities and conveniences of a much larger urban centre.

Education is one of the Swan Hill community's highest priorities. All the region's schools have a strong link to their communities and a firm commitment to the welfare of their students. Facilities include pre-schools, primary schools, secondary colleges, a school for handicapped children and tertiary and further education.

Full medical services are available locally including dentists, pharmacies, allied health professionals and veterinary surgeons. Medical specialists also visit the region regularly.

Our Services

Emergency Department – 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with 17,300 presentations a year from major trauma through high risk illness to the more mundane, but never a dull moment. Employing 7 HMO's and a dedicated team of health professionals, we also utilise the services of our local GP medical group for Anaesthetics and Obstetrics.

There are **thirty five beds** in the Acute Ward, ten beds in the Day Procedure Unit, eight beds in the Midwifery Unit, six in the Renal Dialysis and one Palliative Care bed.

Two operating theatres with VMO's covering Ophthalmology, Orthopaedics, Cardiology, Paediatrics, Gynaecology, Oncology, Ophthalmic Surgery, Geriatric Surgery, Otorhinolaryngology, Urology, as well as our own Surgeons from local practices covering 2,500 procedures a year. Two surgical residents visit from a major Melbourne Hospital on a three monthly rotation system.

Aged Care facilities including the 52 bed unit at Swan Hill and 30 beds in nearby Nyah.

Chemotherapy and **Renal Dialysis** with a six chair service means less stress and distance for the patients.

Primary Care covers a full range of Physiotherapy, Speech therapy, Dietetics, Occupational Therapy, Podiatry and health promotion services.

Pathology and Radiology including 16 slice CT scan and fluoroscopy provide leading edge diagnostic tools.

Last, but by no means least is: Aboriginal Liaison Service, Adult Day Services, Breast Care Nurse, Care Co-ordination, Community Health Nursing, Community Rehabilitation Services, Counseling Services, Dental Services, District Nursing, Domiciliary Midwifery Services, Haemodialysis, Health Clinics, Hospital Admission Risk Program, Hospital in the Home, Meals on Wheels, Palliative Care, Pharmacy, Preparation for Childbirth, Stomal Therapy, Transitional Care, Victorian Aides and Equipment, VAEP – Program for Disabled People
