PUBLIC

- All children aged 0 – 12 years
- Young people aged 13 – 17 years who are health care or pensioner concession card holders or dependants of concession card holders
- People aged 18 years and over, who are health care or pensioner concession card holders or dependants of concession card holders

MEDICARE CHILD DENTAL BENEFITS

The Australian Government introduced the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) which allows children aged 2 – 17 years who receive Family Tax Benefit Part A to access up to \$1013 of free dental care.

If your child is eligible for CDBS and use our clinic there will be no cost up to the maximum value of dental care.

COSTS

General Adult

- **\$30** per visit for course of care
- Maximum fee **\$120.00** per course of care

Denture

- **\$71.50** per denture (full or partial)

Young people 13-17 years

- NO FEE with health care card or CDBS

Children 0-12 years

- NO FEE

All patients aged 13 years and over without a concession card or CDBS are private patients and pay private fees.



All Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander, Asylum Seeker and refugee patients are free if eligible for public services.

PRIVATE



- We provide all general dental services to private patients.
- Our fees are as determined by Dental Health Services of Victoria.
- We are able to process private health fund claims directly through the HICAPS system.
