The Swan Hill District Health Ladies Auxiliary held their Annual General Meeting (AGM) this week. A new constitution was presented and all agreed upon the name of the group to be changed from "Ladies Auxiliary" to "Friends of the Swan Hill Hospital". The new name promotes inclusiveness of all SHDH volunteers.

The group also presented a cheque for \$35,000 to SHDH. It was agreed that these funds will go towards a new industrial dishwasher worth approx. \$150,000. A new dishwasher will enable higher efficiency, enhance Occupational Health and Safety conditions, as well as further improve infection control.

On Wednesday 7th August 2019, Mark Gepp MP officially opened the new Sub Acute Care Service. Thank you to everyone who was able to attend (at short notice), and to everyone who was involved in making the day happen!

The new Sub Acute Care Service welcomed its first patient in May 2019. The service cost approx. \$2,860,000 and was funded partly by the generous donations from a local community group called 'Swan Hill Hospice Committee', Freemasons Victoria and, the Department of Health and Human Services.


THEATRE NEWS


