The position includes exposure to Acute and Aged Care settings.</p> <p>The Graduate Enrolled Nurse is to utilise the program as an opportunity to consolidate and apply learning and professional development to make the transition from student to a skilled practitioner.</p> <p>The Graduate Enrolled Nurse will receive support from the Clinical Nurse Education Team, the NUM and ANUMs within Sub Acute and Aged Care Facility. Support will include orientation, the establishment of individualised Learning Development Plans and ongoing performance review feedback and debriefing.</p> <p>The Graduate Enrolled Nurse will actively participate in the development of individualised learning objectives and seek clinical opportunities to fulfil them.</p> <p>The Graduate Enrolled Nurse is expected to utilise reflective practice as an integral part of clinical practice. The appointee will contribute to the overall performance of the team consistent with Swan Hill District Health Service Purpose and Values.</p>
