New Service at Community Health

We are very excited to advise that we now have a Nurse Practitioner Clinic here at Community Health, specialising in Sexual and Reproductive Health. This is a new service in which individuals can self-refer, for more information or to book a confidential appointment please give us a call.

This new service will compliment and expand our existing Sexual and Reproductive (SRH) Health clinics. Our SRH Nurses provide our Women's Clinic and Clinic 60 (youth health) and will refer to the Nurse Practitioner as required.

The Nurse Practitioner clinic will provide the following services

- Oral contraceptive prescriptions, advice and counselling
- Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) insertion/removal
- Long-Acting Contraception-Contraceptive Injection

- Emergency contraception prescribing and administering
- Prescribing and assisting with medication management
- · Cervical screening
- Unplanned pregnancy options support, including termination of pregnancy
- Diagnostic investigationspathology, radiology and ultrasound referrals
- Referral pathways for specialists
- · Generalist counselling referrals and guidance
- Mental Health Assessments
- Immunisation administration and support
- Menopause liaison and referral
- STI/BBV risk assessment, testing and initiating treatment
- · General health support and education

They are here to educate, advise and support you with any breastfeeding questions or needs you may have, prepregnancy, during pregnancy or post birth.

The benefits of breastfeeding to mother, infant and family are well known, but there are many reasons why breastfeeding can be hard. It is common to need extra help once you go home.

Our service can visit you at home or you can come and see us at Community Health.
